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## Overview

The event took the form of a multi-day Bible seminar (convention) attended by participants from various countries, conducted in Polish with translation into other languages. The event included several thematic sessions devoted to spiritual issues, including reflections on fear and anxiety, the search for true values, and the influence of one's surroundings on the life of a Christian. The seminar took place in Poland, in the vicinity of Wieliczka and Dobczyce, and drew approximately 150-160 registered participants.

## Key Concepts and Theories

- **Fear and Faith** - fear as an inherent part of human nature that can be overcome through faith and trust in God
- **True Values** - the contrast between divine (eternal) values and worldly (transient, illusory) values
- **The Influence of the Environment** - Society, the workplace, the media, and social circles have a significant impact on the life of a Christian
- **The "Perspectives of Eagles and Ravens" Method** - an interactive method of reflecting together on Scripture, based on a variety of perspectives and dialogue
- **The Illusion of the World** - a system of values created by Satan as a false alternative to God's order
